WHAT IS PEAK?

Created by Dr. Mark Dixon, the PEAK Relational Training System is an evaluation and curriculum guide for teaching basic and advanced language skills from a contemporary behavior analytic approach.

PEAK contains 4 separate learning modules to address 4 individual dimensions of language.

Direct Training – basic foundational learning abilities. Examples include eye contact, requesting items, and labeling items)

Generalization – heavily common-core standard driven and designed to take the basic concepts across contexts, stimuli, and people.

Equivalence – designed to teach concept formation and perceptual behavior.

Transformation –produces awareness of the abstract concepts of same, different, opposite, comparison, hierarchy, and perspective taking.
