With deductibles and other insurance costs resetting on 1/1/2024 for many families, we have compiled a list of information about grants that are offered to help offset costs related to caring for a child with autism. Some of the grants are for specific things and others can be used for anything that insurance does not cover. This could include copays, coinsurance, or items, materials, or services that are excluded from your coverage.

Grants Available Anytime:

<u>Autism Diagnostic Evaluation Grant</u> –Provides scholarships for diagnostic testing to financially disadvantaged families with children between the ages of 18 months and 18 years old. We will provide financial assistance ranging from \$500 - \$1,500 per child to help pay for the cost of diagnostic testing for Autism Spectrum Disorder. https://form.jotform.com/232456387135157
